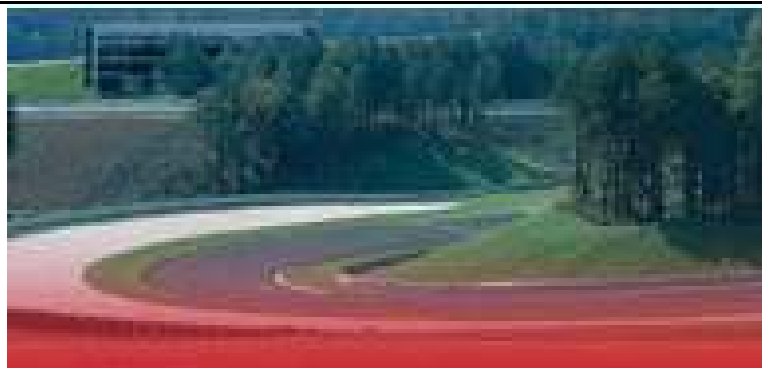

There Will Be Three Rider Groups:

Groups Novice and Intermediate: (Limited to 35 Participants each) - These groups are for street riders with little or no track experience. If you have limited track experience and no racing experience, these are the groups for you. See further explanation on the differences between these two groups below. Novice and Intermediate groups will make paced laps in the first session of each morning. Riders are encouraged to switch between these groups as the day progresses. Groups will be balanced by event organizers to ensure that safe conditions are present at all times.

Group Advanced: (Limited to 45 Participants) - This group is for riders who are licensed racers or have considerable track experience. Spirited pace, riding is largely unrestricted. Very close passes, obvious racing, poor sportsmanship or contact are not permitted.

What's the difference between Novice and Intermediate groups?:

Novice Group Guidelines:

1. Passing is not allowed in the corners. Corners will be defined as the actual corner as well as the entry and exit zones before and after the actual corner.
2. Passing is allowed in the straightaway. 5-10 feet of space must be left between bikes when passing on the straights. No close passing.
3. All riders must demonstrate good and safe riding ability.

Intermediate Group Guidelines:

1. Passing is not allowed in the inside of corners.
2. Passing is allowed in the corners on the outside only and 5-10 feet of clearance and with extreme caution.
3. Passing is allowed in the straightaway with safe clearance.
4. All riders must demonstrate good and safe riding ability.

You will be asked to select your group preference on your sign-up sheet. This selection may affect where you begin the day, but will not restrict you from moving between groups as the day progresses. Participants are encouraged to switch between groups as the day progresses. All group changes must be cleared through race control or an appropriate event official. Riders may be instructed to change groups by event officials; we appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

Each bike will receive a 'group' sticker to be placed in the upper left hand portion of the front fairing. Each group will have a different colored sticker.

We are fortunate to have the opportunity to enjoy the Barber facility. We must abide by their rules or risk not being invited again or ejection. We appreciate your good judgement and reasonable behavior. Poor judgement and unreasonable behavior will not be accepted.

Bogart's seeks to host a safe, fun and enjoyable event at this extraordinary facility. Our priorities are: 1. Your safety and the safety of all organizers and spectators, 2. The enjoyment and learning of all participants, organizers and spectators. Thank you for joining us for this unique event.

Safety Gear and Technical Inspection Requirements:

Every rider and every motorcycle going onto the track must pass Technical Inspection (Tech). Upon passing Tech each bike will receive a sticker to be placed on the upper right hand portion (from rider's perspective) of the front fairing. There will be a different sticker for each group.

Safety Gear Requirements:

- **Full Coverage Helmet** - Snell or DOT approved with snap-close face shield
- **Gloves** - Full coverage gloves that cover the wrist cuff
- **Boots** - must cover ankle and ankle cuffs
- **Jacket & Pants*** - Leather or heavy synthetic textile motorcycle jacket and similar pants, preferably with armor, and preferably zip-together.
 - Joe Rocket Phoenix, First Gear Mesh-Tex, BMW Wind Machine, Vanson Textile mesh jackets and other similar "light vented" or "free air" equipment is not allowed. "Heavy Vented" such as BMW Aeroflow, perforated leather, etc. is acceptable. Natural fiber clothing, such as jeans, are not acceptable. If in doubt, bring more than one option.
 - ***C Group riders** must have full coverage leather or high quality textile suits (one piece or zip together two piece suits), preferably with armor.
- All riding equipment must be in very good condition. This will be strictly enforced.

Motorcycle Requirements:

- Prepare your bike in advance.
 - Bring tools and supplies with you. Bogart's will not provide supplies or tools.
- Your bike should:**
- Coolant should be flushed and replaced with distilled water or Redline/water mix.
 - Except Street group, oil fill cap, oil drain plug and filter should be safety wired.
 - Be clean and in very good mechanical condition.
 - Not leaking any fluid whatsoever.
 - Have bodywork attached in a safe manner or removed. No parts dragging.
 - Have kickstand and centerstand in good working order, retracting and holding in place, or it must be safety wired or removed.
 - Have the license plates and plate holders removed.
 - Have the mirrors, headlights, taillights and turn signals taped (disconnect lights before taping them) or removed.
 - **Have new condition tires** with plenty of tread depth. You will not be allowed on the track if your tires demonstrate excessive wear.
 - Have brakes operating properly and have plenty of brake pad material.
 - Have a self-closing throttle from all handlebar positions.
 - Have a properly adjusted chain and in good condition.

Failure to adhere to any tech requirements or procedures at any time will disqualify you from riding in this event and your money will NOT be refunded. Your motorcycle and riding gear will be inspected prior to the start of the event. Our inspection in no way guarantees your safety in this event. You are responsible for properly preparing your motorcycle for safe operation and it is your responsibility to check your motorcycle to assure that it will pass our technical inspection.

In the event of a crash, your bike and gear must be completely re-teched before you are allowed to proceed. Failure to adhere to any tech requirements or procedures at any time will disqualify you from riding in this event and your money will not be refunded. If anything attached to your bike touches the ground or is observed to touch the ground you will be asked to remove the offending part or ride in a manner that will not drag the part.

SAFETY GEAR

- Helmet - Snell or DOT approved, full coverage
- Face shield - snaps closed
- Gloves - full coverage in non-torn condition, covering the wrist cuffs
- Boots - in non-torn condition and cover ankle/cuffs
- Street/Track Groups - leather or heavy textile motorcycle jacket/pants
- Adv. Group - full coverage leather suits or Aerostich-like with armor

MOTORCYCLE

Bodywork and Frame

- Track/Adv. Groups – Oil fill, drain and filter wired.
- Coolant flushed, replace w/ water/redline
- All bodywork/fasteners tight/secured
- Centerstand either removed or return spring in good working order
- Kickstand either removed or return spring in good working order
- License plates removed
- Headlights, taillights, mirrors, and turn signals taped or removed
- Footpegs secure (tight)
- Clip-ons or handlebars tight
- No open pipes. Barber MP monitors sound levels; vehicles exceeding 104dB must adjust.

Brakes, Controls and Drive train

- Chain adjusted and lubricated properly
- Rear sprocket wear minimum
- Firm front and rear brake lever feel
- Brake pads have acceptable life remaining
- Throttle is self-closing at all handlebar positions
- Clutch lever action acceptable

Fluids

- No fluid leakage - fuel, coolant, oil, brake fluid
- Full tank of gas. Barber's has a gas pump in the paddock. However, it has broken down before. To be safe, arrive with a full tank and bring extra. You may ride as many as 130 miles/day.
- Oil level acceptable

Tires

- Tires in new or nearly new condition
- Tires properly inflated

- Apply Tech Sticker on upper right front fairing and chin of helmet.

From Atlanta - Going west on I-20, take exit number 140 towards Leeds. Turn left off the exit, taking Highway 78 East. Turn right before the Chevron Station onto Rex Lake Rd. Turn right onto Barber Motorsports Parkway.

From Birmingham - Going east on I-20, take exit number 140 towards Leeds. Turn right off the exit, taking Highway 78 East. Turn right before the Chevron Station onto Rex Lake Road. Turn right onto Barber Motorsports Parkway.

Barbers Vintage Motorsports Museum :

The 141,000 square foot museum houses a collection of over 800 vintage motorcycles. The entrance fee to the museum is not included in your track day fee. Museum admission rates are \$10 for Adults, \$6.00 for Children ages 4-12, and FREE for Children 3 and under. Hours of operation from April 1 to September 30, Monday - Saturday 10am - 6pm, Sunday Noon - 6pm.

Food and Drink:

Water will be available at the track. You must bring other food and drink as you wish.

Refunds: A full refund is available prior to 30 days before the event. One half refund is available prior to 14 days from the event. NO REFUNDS ARE AVAILABLE WITHIN 14 DAYS OF EVENT. The event will be held Rain or Shine.

Gate Fee: There is no gate fee for participants, volunteers, or corner workers. There may be a gate fee assessed on non-participants. This is largely controlled by Zoom Motorsports and Barber Motorsports Park. We have asked that no gate fee be charged. This may change at their discretion. We appreciate your understanding.

Medical: There will be two ambulances at the track for this event. No medical facility or coverage of any kind will be provided.

Passengers: Passengers will be allowed to ride in the Novice group, session #2 or later. Passengers will be held to the same tech requirements as riders and must attend the rider's meeting.

2006 RULES AND REGULATIONS

Management shall have the right to add to or amend the rules and regulations at any time. Park security has final say on enforcement of all park rules and regulations.

General Park Rules:

- No entrance into restricted areas without proper credentials.
- NO pets on facility grounds except those required to assist handicapped individuals.
- No Jumping of fences
- No glass containers allowed on property at any time.
- Spectators are not allowed to rope off any areas. Scaffolding is prohibited.
- Speed limits: posted speed limits must be obeyed at all times. Where not posted otherwise, speed limit is fifteen (15) miles per hour throughout the BMP.
- All trash must be placed in proper trash receptacles
- Management may expel or bar any individual for violation of any rule, as determined by management's sole discretion
- No abusive behavior or vandalism. Either could result in ejection and/or arrest
- No unlawful activities. Federal, state, and local laws must be obeyed.
- No flyers or handbills may be distributed unless prior approval is obtained from management
- No fireworks, firearms, or weapons are permitted on facility grounds
- ATV's, ATC's, golf carts, pit cars, pit bikes, bicycles, and other pit vehicles are permitted in the paddock area only, Common sense and care must be applied in their use. All drivers / riders of pit vehicles must carry a valid driver's license. Operate vehicles only on paved surfaces.
- Motor vehicles operating outside the paddock MUST BE Street legal.
- Minors are not allowed to operate bicycles at any time anywhere at the Park.
- Parent must accompany minors at all times while in the paddock.
- No skateboards, roller skates, roller blades, razor scooters, or any similar type items allowed anywhere at the Park.
- No loud music
- No alcohol allowed in the paddock
- No smoking around team areas or fueling areas.
- Smoking in any building is strictly prohibited. Please do not throw extinguished cigarettes on the ground.
- Do not damage grassed areas
- NO campfires or ground fires are allowed on park property. Grills are allowed only in camping areas.
- NO spectators allowed on track at any time.
- No stakes of any kind may be driven into paved surfaces; care must be taken when vehicle jacks are used to prevent the jack from sinking into a paved surface (such as placing a large enough piece of wood under the jack so that the weight is distributed over enough area that the pavement will not get "dented"). Kickstands on asphalt must have something under them to distribute the weight.
- Helmets must be worn on perimeter road at all times when operating two wheeled motorized vehicles
- Cameras, lawn chairs, blankets, and coolers are welcome.
- Coolers are allowed, but are subject to search by Park security or Park management.
- Overnight Camping – please see specific rules and regulation pertaining to overnight camping

Participant Guidelines:

- **In 2006, Barber Motorsports Park will monitor sound levels from a fixed location with 104 db being the maximum acceptable level. Anyone with a sound level above 104 dB will be asked to make adjustments to comply.**
- **NO unmuffled engines may be started before 8am nor after 8pm, or during the mandatory daily quiet hr.**
- Any and all fuel and/or oil spills in the paddock must be cleaned by User and disposed of in proper receptacles
- Vehicles may be serviced only on paved areas in the paddock
- No banners may be hung or attached to any facilities or structures unless prior approval is obtained from management
- Waste oil, waste fuel, and/or waste coolant must be disposed of in proper waste drums – violators will be held accountable for fines and/or fees associated with improper disposal. Clean up fees on a cost plus basis.
- Any hazardous material (tires, batteries, fuel cans, etc...) must be removed from premises. Violators will be held responsible for all fines and/or fees associated with the removal of hazardous materials.
- Any fuel containers brought on site must be removed by user.
- Notices and other Event related information must be posted only on provided bulletin boards.
- Each participant must have 1 portable dry fire extinguisher with a minimum rating of 12 BC available and in good working order in their pit area
- No imbedding of brakes and/or testing vehicles on any surfaces other than the motor vehicle track
- No open toed shoes allowed in hot pit areas.
