Any person who is born on or after Jan. 1, 1985 must have completed and received a snowmobile safety certificate in order to operate a snowmobile in Wisconsin. The certificate must be carried while operating the snowmobile, and displayed to a law enforcement officer upon demand. The cost of a classroom/in person course is \$10.00.

Snowmobile Safety courses are also available online at: <https://www.snowmobile-ed.com/wi/>. DNR will no longer be utilizing the CD version of the course. The fee will be \$15.00, the minimum age is 16. Anyone under age 16 is required by law to complete a classroom course.
