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Death Valley

Death Valley National Park, established on February 11, 1933, is made up of 3,336,000 acres and contains more than 3,000,000 acres of wilderness.

The floor of the Valley is almost 300 feet below sea level (at Badwater basin) and it is recognized as the lowest point in the Western Hemisphere and one of the hottest places on earth.

This unique national park is open all year, but winter is the best time to visit the points of interest in the valley.

Federal Land - 3,317,470.67

Non-Federal Land - 50,156.21

Gross Area Acres - 3,367,626.88

Visitation is highest from February through mid April. The month of November is also busy. Visitation is lowest in December and January.

Depart Henderson Harley-Davidson Turn LEFT (North) onto N Gibson Rd
Turn LEFT (West) onto W Sunset Rd, then immediately bear RIGHT (North-West) onto Ramp
Merge onto I-515 [US-93]
Take Ramp (RIGHT) onto US-95 Bus [SR-599]
Keep STRAIGHT onto Invite Rd
Turn LEFT (South) onto SR-373
Entering California
Road name changes to SR-127
Turn RIGHT (West) onto SR-190
Arrive Death Valley



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
